## THE TRIP AND THE ROUTE:

The world Famous Jeepers Jamboree starts in Georgetown at sunrise on Thursday and Friday mornings. Vehicles go east over approximately 25 miles of paved road and 20 miles of dirt road to Wentworth Springs. About 22 miles above Georgetown the road crosses the dam at Lake Edson and passes the old cattleman's stop of Uncle Tom's Cabin. The road winds through forests of virgin pine and fir timber. At Wentworth Springs the going gets tough, almost all 4-wheel drive at 3 to 5 miles per hour. The trail goes across granite slabs ground smooth by glaciers, past the Devil's Postpile over thousands of tons of boulders, and through occasional streams. The trail passes Spider and Buck Island Lakes (Loon and Rock Bound Lakes are visible in the distance). Rubicon Springs (alt. 6500 ft.), our overnight spot, was an early 1870 mineral springs resort.

Sunday we depart with a few more miles of tough going and then paved highway at Homewood. From there it is a pleasant drive to the south end of Lake Tahoe for a farewell dinner at the Elks Club.

**WHAT TO BRING:** One shovel per vehicle. Fork, knife, spoon and a sleeping bag per person. Suggested additional items: Change of clothing, jacket for evening, swim suit and towel, camera and film, fishing gear, lotion and insect repellent, rubber sole shoes, 1 flashlight per person, and a cool box full of your favorite beverages. Suggest you bring a small tent or good tarp. We had 1 day of rain on the '76 trip.

JEEPERS JAMBOREE is a non-profit organization dedicated to annual week-ends of fun.

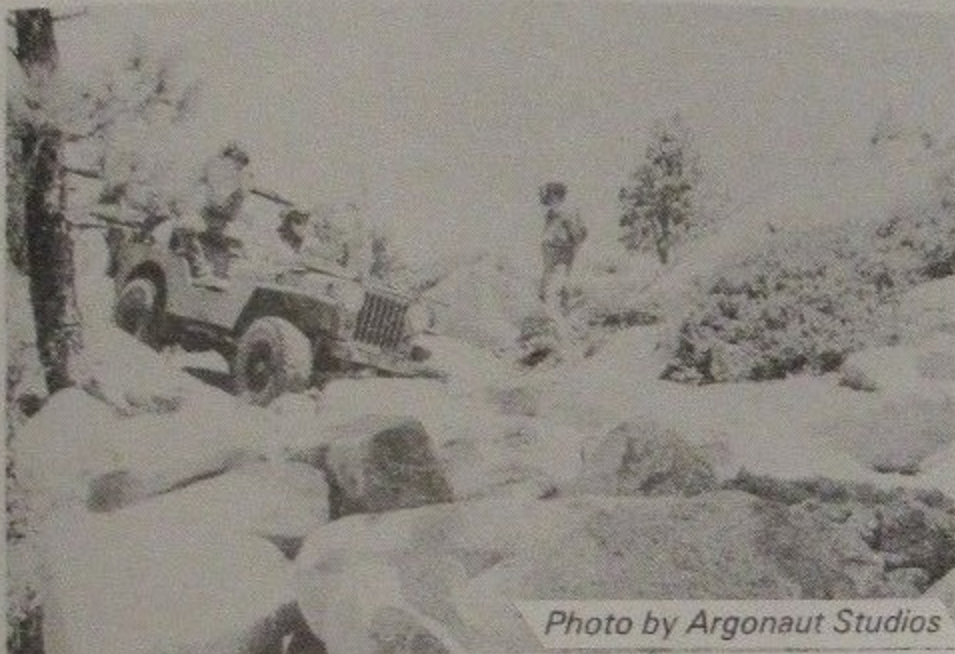

**IF YOU HAVE A NEW VEHICLE AND FEAR DENTING IT, DON'T COME.** Odds are you will take dents home with you. A suggestion: remove hub caps and Jeep steps.

**VEHICLES** should be in good mechanical condition, with good tires and brakes. A full tank of gas in Georgetown should take you through to the Lake. Suggest: a 5 gallon can of gas.

**In Georgetown:** Limited motel and hotel accommodations are available. There are good eating spots in Georgetown. Campsites are available near town. The Rubicon Trail will be closed for the exclusive use of the **Jeepers Jamboree.** Rubicon Springs will be leased exclusively for the Jamboree. There will be express lines at Georgetown and Rubicon for Breakfast of coffee, juice and rolls. There will be music and entertainment Friday night in Georgetown and Friday and Saturday nights in Rubicon Springs.

**THREE WATER TRUCKS** will be used to keep the dust settled on the road between Georgetown and Wentworth Springs.

**Mileages:** Georgetown to Wentworth Springs, 45; Wentworth to Rubicon, 7 1/2; Rubicon to Chambers at Tahoe, 91 1/2; Georgetown from Sacramento, 48; to Placerville, 16; to Auburn, 19.

**Jeepers Jamboree** is considered the toughest and largest organized event of this type in the world. It has had worldwide publicity through TV, radio, magazines and newspapers.

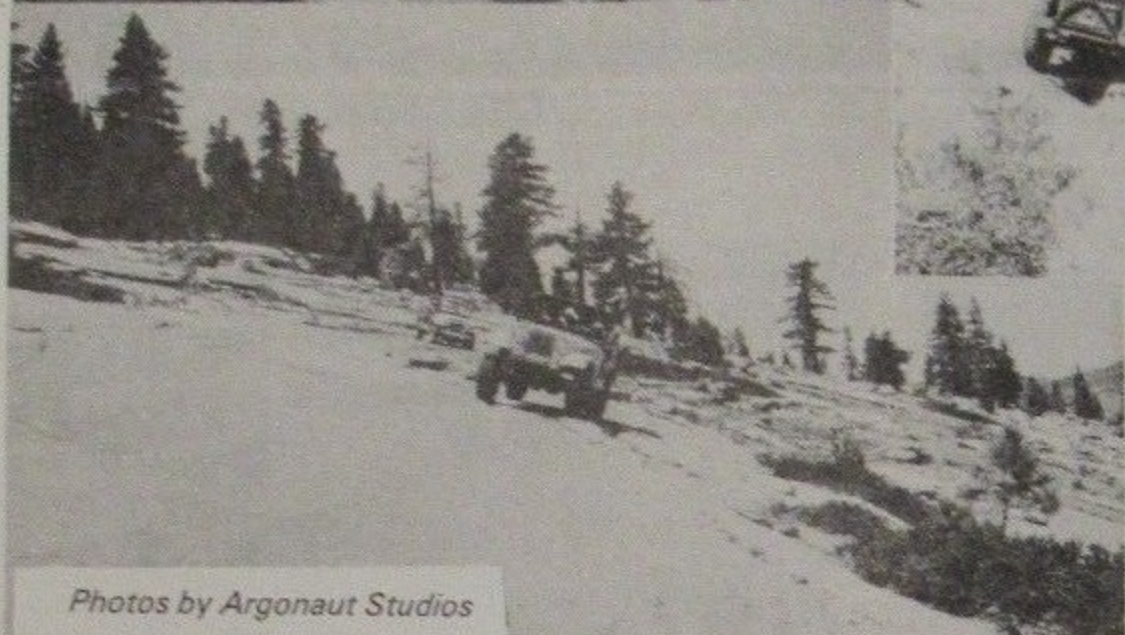
